5 Laws of Sowing and Reaping



1. The Law of Implantation

Galatians 6:7 Do not be
deceived: God cannot be mocked.
A man reaps what he sows.--
(NIV)

Principle

To Reap Someone Must Sow.



³⁶ Even now the reaper draws his wages, even now he harvests the crop for eternal life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together. ³⁷ Thus the saying 'One sows and another reaps' is true. ³⁸ I sent you to reap what you have not worked for. Others have done the hard work, and you have reaped the benefits of their labor.'-- (NIV)

2. The Law Of Identification

Galatians 6:8 For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.-- (ESV)

Principle

You Reap The Same As You Sow.



¹¹ And God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its kind, on the earth." And it was so. ¹² The earth brought forth vegetation, plants yielding seed according to their own kinds, and trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.-- (ESV)

3. The Law of **Incubation**

Mark 4:26–27²⁶ He also said, “This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. ²⁷ Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. (NIV)

Principle

You Reap **Later Than** You Sow.



Ecclesiastes 11:1

Cast your bread upon the waters, for after many days you will find it again.-- (NIV)

4. The Law of Intensification

Galatians 6:9 Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.-- (NIV)

Principle

You Reap More Than You Sow.



Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, multiplying thirty, sixty, or even a hundred times.”-- (NIV)

**Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.--

⁶ Remember that the person who sows few seeds will have a small crop; the one who sows many seeds will have a large crop. ⁷ You should each give, then, as you have decided, not with regret or out of a sense of duty; for God loves the one who gives gladly. ⁸ And God is able to give you more than you need, so that you will always have all you need for yourselves and more than enough for every good cause. ⁹ As the scripture says: “He gives generously to the needy; his kindness lasts for ever.” ¹⁰ And God, who supplies seed to sow and bread to eat, will also supply you with all the seed you need and will make it grow and produce a rich harvest from your generosity. ¹¹ He will always make you rich enough to be generous at all times, so that many will thank God for your gifts which they receive from us.-- (GNB)
