The Miracle of the Message

1. God Speaks To Us In <u>*Various</u> Ways.

Hebrews 1:11 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets,-- (ESV)

A. God Speaks To Us Through Creation

Hebrews 1:22 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.-- (ESV)



20 For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.-- (NIV)

B. God Speaks Through Our Conscience

Romans 2:15 They show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their consciences also bearing witness, and their thoughts sometimes accusing them and at other times even defending them.-- (NIV)

C. God Speaks To Us Through Circumstances.

Hebrews 1:1 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, (ESV)

Exodus 3:2–3

² There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. 3 So Moses thought, "I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up."-- (NIV)

D. God Speaks To Us Through His Word

Jonah 3:1 Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time:-- (NIV)

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any doubleedged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.-- (NIV)

John 14:8-11

8 Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us." 9 Jesus answered: "Don't you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you I do not speak on my own authority. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work. 11 Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the works themselves.-- (NIV)
