## 1. The Moment the Word Became Flesh.

Isaiah 7:14 <sup>14</sup> Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel. (NIV)

# 2. The Miracle of the Word Becoming Flesh

John 1:14 <sup>14</sup> The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

#### **Luke 2:7**

<sup>7</sup> and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.-- (NIV)



Matthew 1:23<sup>23</sup> "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us"). -- (NIV)

### B. His Birth Was A \_\_\_\_\_ Birth.

Matthew 1:21<sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." - (NIV)

#### Romans 5:12

12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned—-- (NIV)

### 3. The Motive of the Word Becoming Flesh.

John 1:14<sup>14</sup> The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.-- (NIV)

### A. Jesus Became One With Us.

Hebrews 4:15<sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.-- (NIV)

### B. Jesus Became One For Us

Hebrews 2:14<sup>14</sup> Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. (NLT)
