
### A Heart For The Lost



#### Luke 15:1-10

1 Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. 2 But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." 3 Then Jesus told them this parable:

4 "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? 5 And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders <sup>6</sup> and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep."

<sup>7</sup> I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. 8 "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it?

<sup>9</sup> And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin." 10 In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."-- (NIV)

# Lessons Learned From the Lost Sheep

1. Jesus Initiates Reaching The Lost. Luke 15:44 "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?-- (NIV)

### A. Sheep Are Dumb.

Isaiah 53:66 All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the LORD laid on him the sins of us all.-- (NLT)

### B. Sheep Are Dependent.

Psalm 23:22 He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, (NIV)

### C. Sheep Are Defenseless

Psalm 23:44 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.--(NIV)

1. The Father's Love Is Patient

#### **2 Peter 3:9**

Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.-- (NIV)
