

Ezra 6:14






1. Encouraged To Give God Priority

B. The Evidence of Prophecy.

Ezra 1:1-3¹ In the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the Lord by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, so that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom and also put it in writing: 2 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: The Lord, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth, and he has charged me to build him a house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah. 3 Whoever is among you of all his people, may his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and rebuild the house of the Lord, the God of Israel he is the God who is in Jerusalem.-- (ESV)





Matthew 6:33

2. Encouraged To Claim God's Promises

Haggai 1:99 You hoped for rich harvests, but they were poor. And when you brought your harvest home, I blew it away. Why? Because my house lies in ruins, says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, while all of you are busy building your own fine houses.-- (NLT)

2 Corinthians 9:8, **10**

- 8 And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.

2 Samuel 7:1-31 When King David was settled in his palace and the LORD had given him rest from all the surrounding enemies, ² the king summoned Nathan the prophet. "Look," David said, "I am living in a beautiful cedar palace, but the Ark of God is out there in a tent!" 3 Nathan replied to the king, "Go ahead and do whatever you have in mind, for the Lord is with you."-- (NLT)

3. To Provide <u>Space</u> For Enlarged Ministry.

Isaiah 54:2-32 "Enlarge your house; build an addition. Spread out your home, and spare no expense! 3 For you will soon be bursting at the seams (NLT)

Haggai 1:88 Go up into the mountains and bring down timber and build the house, so that I may take pleasure in it and be honored," says the LORD.-- (NIV)
