



How To Build A Friendship With God

1. Make Knowing God My #1 Priority.

Philippians 3:88 Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I may know Christ (NLT)

Psalm 46:10¹⁰ He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."-- (NIV)



Matthew 6:5-6

⁵ "And when you come before God, don't turn that into a theatrical production either....⁶ "Here's what I want you to do: Find a quiet, secluded place so you won't be tempted to role-play before God. Just be there as simply and honestly as you can manage. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace.-- (The Msg.)

3. Decide Whose Friendship You Want Most
