4 Traits of Awesome Families

1. Awesome Families Are Playful

Ecclesiastes 8:15¹⁵ So I commend the enjoyment of life, because there is nothing better for a person under the sun than to eat and drink and be glad. Then joy will accompany them in their toil all the days of the life God has given them under the sun.-- (NIV)

How Do We Learn From Our Families

A. We Learn Through Example John 13:14-15¹⁴ And since I have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other's feet. 15 I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you.-- (NLT)

C. We Do NOT Learn Through Criticizing

D. We Do NOT Learn Through Comparing.

Galatians 6:4⁴ Each person should judge his own actions and not compare himself with others. Then he can be proud for what he himself has done.-- (NCV)
