

Luke 8:41–56⁴¹ Then a man named Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, came and fell at Jesus' feet, pleading with him to come to his house⁴² because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying. As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him.⁴³ And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years, but no one could heal her.



44 She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped. 45 “Who touched me?” Jesus asked. When they all denied it, Peter said, “Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you.”



46 But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me." 47 Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed.



48 Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace." 49 While Jesus was still speaking, someone came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue ruler. "Your daughter is dead," he said. "Don't bother the teacher any more."

50 Hearing this, Jesus said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; just believe, and she will be healed."



51 When he arrived at the house of Jairus, he did not let anyone go in with him except Peter, John and James, and the child's father and mother. 52 Meanwhile, all the people were wailing and mourning for her. "Stop wailing," Jesus said. "She is not dead but asleep." 53 They laughed at him, knowing that she was dead.



54 But he took her by the hand and said, "My child, get up!" 55 Her spirit returned, and at once she stood up. Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat. 56 Her parents were astonished, but he ordered them not to tell anyone what had happened.-- (NIV)

1. Dad's Determined Faith Is Revealed.


A. He Was A Prestigious Man.

2. Dad's Deepest Fear Is Realized.

A. The Obstacles He Encountered.
1.) He Encountered Delay.

2.) He Encountered Denial.

3.) He Encountered Doubt.

Luke 8:50⁵⁰ But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she will be healed."-- (ESV)



James 1:6-7

6 But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. 7 That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.-- (NIV)



B. The Opposition He Endured.


Mark 5:39–40³⁹ He went in and said to them, “Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep.”⁴⁰ But they laughed at him. After he put them all out, he took the child’s father and mother and the disciples who were with him, and went in where the child was.--(NIV)



3. Dad's Blessed Future Is Revived.

A. He Witnessed A Power Most Remarkable.

Luke 8:51⁵¹ When they arrived at the house, Jesus wouldn't let anyone go in with him except Peter, John, James, and the little girl's father and mother.-- (NLT)



Luke 8:54–55

54 Then Jesus took her by the hand and said in a loud voice, “My child, get up!” 55 And at that moment her life returned, and she immediately stood up! Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat.-- (NLT)



Mark 5:42

42 And the girl, who was twelve years old, immediately stood up and walked around! They were overwhelmed and totally amazed.-- (NLT)



B. He Witnessed A Priority
