


⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

(I never have enough and I never will. Biblical adjectives: Lacking, Wanting, and Need.)



2. A Surplus Mindset.

(God has more than I will ever need. Biblical adjectives: Abundance, Overflowing, Plentiful.)

Psalm 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. (NKJV)


Psalm 23:5c

How Can I Experience An Overflowing Life?

1. I Stay Connected To Jesus Everyday.

John 15:5 "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. (NIV)

John 15:7-11

⁷ But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! 8 My true disciples produce much fruit. This brings great glory to my Father. 9 11. . . Remain in my love. 10, you remain in my love when you obey me, ¹¹ I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow! (NLT)

Stop Complaining & Start Thanking. Philippians 2:14 In everything you do, stay away from complaining and arguing,-- (NLT)

Colossians 2:7

Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.



3. I Stop Comparing & Start Being Contented.

2 Corinthians 10:12 Oh, don't worry; . . . But they are only comparing themselves with each other, . . . How foolish!



4. I Stop Being Stingy & Start Being Generous.

2 Corinthians 9:6—8 6 Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. 7 You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully." 8 And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.-- (NLT)

Luke 6:38

Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back."
