${ }^{36}$ Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go overthere and pray." ${ }^{37} \mathrm{He}$ took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee along with him, and he began to be sorrowful and troubled. 38 Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."

39 Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed $b$ "My Father, if it is possible, (may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will." 40 Then the returned to his disciples andlyouind them sleeping. "Could you men nots keep watch with me for one hour? he asked Peter. 41 "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak:

45 Then he returned to the disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Look, the houris near, and the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners. ${ }^{46}$ Rise, let us go! Nere comes my betrayer!"
