Deuteronomy 32:3


³ I will proclaim the name of the Lord. Oh, praise the greatness of our God!

Isaiah 41:10-13

10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. 11 "All who rage against you will surely be ashamed and disgraced; those who oppose you will be as nothing and perish.

12 Though you search for your enemies, you will not find them. Those who wage war against you will be as nothing at all. 13 For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you. (NIV)

God Is Great Enough To Deserve My Trust



1. The Comfort of His Righteous Hand.

Isaiah 41:10 10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. (NIV)

Psalm 9:8

⁸ He will judge the world in righteousness; he will govern the peoples with justice. (NIV)

2 Timothy 4:8

8 Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing. (NIV)

2. The Comfort of His Powerful Hand.

A. The Power To Create

Isaiah 48:13 ¹³ My own hand laid the foundations of the earth, and my right hand spread out the heavens; when I summon them, they all stand up together. (NIV)

B. The Power To Protect.

Exodus 15:6 ⁶ Your right hand, O LORD, was majestic in power. Your right hand, O LORD, shattered the enemy. (NIV)

C. The Power To Provide

1 Chronicles 29:12 12 Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all. (NIV)

3. The Comfort of An Intervening Hand.

Psalm 18:16-17 ¹⁶ He reached down from on high and took hold of me; he drew me out of deep waters. ¹⁷ He rescued me from my powerful enemy, from my foes, who were too strong for me. (NIV)

Psalm 18:35-36

35 You give me your shield of victory, and your right hand sustains me; you stoop down to make me great. 36 You broaden the path beneath me, so that my ankles do not turn. (NIV)

Psalm 37:23-24

23 If the Lord delights in a man's way, he makes his steps firm; 24 though he stumble, he will not fall, for the LORD upholds him with his hand. (NIV)

4. The Comfort of His Disciplining Hand.

A. God Uses Discipline To **Correct** Me.

Psalm 32:3-5 3 When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. 4 For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer. 5 Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord"— and you forgave the guilt of my sin. (NIV)

Job 2:10

10 But Job replied, "You talk like a foolish woman. Should we accept only good things from the hand of God and never anything bad?" So in all this, Job said nothing wrong.-- (NLT)

B. God Uses Discipline To Shape Me.

Isaiah 64:8 8 Yet, O Lord, you are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand. (NIV)

5. The Comfort of His Satisfying Hand.

Psalm 145:15-16 15 The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. 16 You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing. (NIV)

Psalm 107:9

⁹ For He satisfies the longing soul, And fills the hungry soul with goodness. (NKJV)

6. The Comfort of His Anointing Hand.

Acts 11:20-21 20 But some of them were men from Cyprus and Cyrene, who, when they had come to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists, preaching the Lord Jesus. 21 And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the Lord. (NKJV)
