

#### **Psalm 91:1-6**

<sup>1</sup> He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. <sup>2</sup> I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." <sup>3</sup> Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. <sup>4</sup> He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. <sup>5</sup> You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, <sup>6</sup> nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. <sup>15</sup> He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. <sup>16</sup> With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation." ## What Can God Do?

El-Shaddai – comes from Hebrew word "sadday" which derived from the Akkadian word "sadu" which means mountain. It describes God's power, majesty and strength.

**1. God Cannot Act Inconsistent** With His Character. Job 34:12<sup>12</sup> Surely, God cannot act wickedly, the Almighty cannot violate justice.-- (NAB)

### 3. God Cannot Wink At Sin.

Exodus 34:7<sup>7</sup> I lavish unfailing love to a thousand generations. I forgive iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But I do not excuse the guilty...(NLT)

#### 5. God Cannot Punish An <u>Innocent</u> Person.

### Four Principles of God's Power 1. God's Power Is Unusual Psalm 89:88 O Lord God Almighty, who is like you? You are mighty, O LORD, and your faithfulness surrounds you.

#### Jeremiah 32:17

<sup>17</sup> Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

### 2. God's Power Is Available

Isaiah 40:28–31<sup>28</sup> Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom.

<sup>29</sup> He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. <sup>30</sup> Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; <sup>31</sup> but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

## 3. God's Power Is

2 Peter 1:3<sup>3</sup> His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. (NIV)

## 4. God's Power Is Purposeful

#### Psalm 57:2<sup>2</sup> I cry out to God Most High, to God, who fulfills his purpose for me.



<sup>8</sup> But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

#### How Can I Release God's Power In My Life? Dwell with Him. 1. I Must Psalm 91:1<sup>1</sup> He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

### 2. I Must <u>Call</u> on Him.

Psalm 91:15<sup>15</sup> He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.

### 3. I Must Love Him.

Psalm 91:14 <sup>14</sup> "Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

## 4. I Must Trust

### Him.

Psalm 91:2<sup>2</sup> I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
