

2. Giving Draws Me Closer to God.





3. Giving Is The Antidote To Materialism

1 Timothy 6:17-19 17 Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. 18 Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. 19 In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.

5. Giving Is An Investment in Eternity



7. Giving Makes Me Happy.

Acts 20:35 ³⁵ In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"



What Is The Difference Between A "Tithe" And An "Offering"?

- A "tithe" is giving First 10% of my income.
- An "offering" is anything I give In Addition to my tithe.

1. Because God

Commands It

Leviticus 27:30 ³⁰ " 'A tithe of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the LORD; it is holy to the LORD.

2. Because Jesus Commends It.

Matthew 23:23c Yes, you should tithe, but you shouldn't leave the more important things undone. (TLB)

3. Tithing Demonstrates That God Has 1st Place In My Life.

Deuteronomy 14:23b The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives. (TLB)

4. Tithing reminds me that **Everything I Have** was given to me by God!

Deuteronomy 8:18 ¹⁸ But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your forefathers, as it is today. (NIV)

5. Tithing expresses my Love to The Lord

Psalm 116:12 ¹² How can I repay the Lord for all his goodness to me?

Deuteronomy 16:17 ¹⁷ Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the LORD your God has blessed you.

6. God says that refusing to tithe is Stealing from Him!

Malachi 3:8-10a 8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me. "But you ask, 'How do we rob you?' "In tithes and offerings. 9 You are under a curse—the whole nation of you—because you are robbing me. 10 Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. (NIV)

7. Tithing gives God a chance to prove EXISTS and wants to bless you!

Malachi 3:10-11 10 Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it. 11 I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not cast their fruit," says the LORD Almighty. (NIV)

8. Tithing Shows That I Love God.





John 14:15 15 "If you love me, you will obey what I command.

The Key:

2 Corinthians 8:5 ⁵ And they did not do as we expected, but they gave themselves first to the Lord and then to us in keeping with God's will.
