Mark 1:19¹⁹ When he had gone a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John in a boat, preparing their nets.



20 Without delay he called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired men and followed him.

C. Salome Is a Follower of Jesus Christ.

Mark 15:40–41⁴⁰ Some women . . .

Salome. ⁴¹ In Galilee these women had followed Him . . . (NIV)



D. Salome Is a Supporter of Jesus.

Mark 15:40–41⁴⁰ Some women were watching from a distance. Among them were . . . Salome. ⁴¹ In Galilee these women had followed him and cared for his needs.



E. Salome Is a Witness at The Crucifixion.

Mark 15:40⁴⁰ Some women were watching from a distance. Among them were Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James the younger and of Joseph, and Salome.



F. Salome Is a Witness at The Resurrection.

Mark 16:1¹ When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body.

Mark 16:6⁶ "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him.



G. Salome Is a Witness of Christ.

Luke 24:9⁹ When they came back from the tomb, they told all these things to the Eleven and to all the others.-- (NIV)



5 Lessons From Salome's Encounter With Jesus

1. Salome's Approach To Jesus.
