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# **Deuteronomy 5:29**

**29** Oh, that their hearts would be inclined to fear me and keep all my commands always, so that it might go well with them and their children forever!

## **Deuteronomy 6:1–9**

**1 These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess,**

<sup>2</sup> so that you, your children and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live by keeping all his decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life.

**3 Hear, O Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your fathers, promised you. 4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.**

**5 Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. 6 These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.**

**7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. 9 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.-- (NIV)**

## A. Children Get Their Concept of Self in the Home.

Ephesians 2:10 <sup>10</sup> For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.-- (NLT)

## B. Children Get Their Concept of Life in the Home.

Proverbs 29:15<sup>15</sup> The rod of correction imparts wisdom, but a child left to himself disgraces his mother.-- (NIV)

**3. The \_\_\_\_\_ Are the Curriculum.**

**Deuteronomy 6:8–9<sup>8</sup> Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. <sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.-- (NIV)**

## **4. Your Children Are the Students.**

**Deuteronomy 6:7<sup>7</sup> You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.-- (ESV)**

## **5. Life Is The Laboratory.**

**Deuteronomy 6:7<sup>7</sup> Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.-- (NIV)**

## A. Teach God's Word with Conviction.

Deuteronomy 6:6–7<sup>6</sup> These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. <sup>7</sup> Impress them on your children. . . .



**B. Teach God's Word Consistently.**

**Deuteronomy 6:7<sup>7</sup> Repeat them again  
and again to your children. . . . .-- (NLT)**



# **Isaiah 28:10**

**10 He tells us everything over and over—  
one line at a time, one line at a time, a  
little here, and a little there!”**

**c. Teach God's Word Creatively.**

**Deuteronomy 6:8<sup>8</sup> Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders.**

## **D. Teach God's Word Conversationally**

**Deuteronomy 6:7b<sup>7</sup> Talk about them  
when you are at home and when you are  
on the road, when you are going to bed  
and when you are getting up.--**

## **E. Teach God's Word Conspicuously.**

**Deuteronomy 6:9<sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.**



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
